Carter Towers, Putman Manor, Ransdorf Manor Reminders:

*Do NOT Prop open balcony doors, laundry room doors, garbage room doors, or any other building entry door. Doing this affects the security of the building as well as allows insects and other pests to enter the building.

* Store all personal items inside your dwelling unit. Common areas such as lobbies, hallways, balconies, walkways, etc. must be kept clear of all personal items.

Pennsylvania Helmet Law

Children under the age of 12 years old **MUST** wear a helmet while riding a bicycle under state law.

Pennsylvania's mandatory bicycle helmet law applies to children operating bicycles and to children who are passengers in a restraining seat or trailer.

Cutting and Trimming Lawns

PROPER LAWN CARE

When mowing your grass, make sure that you are also trimming. Trimming means cutting the grass around your building, sheds, sidewalks, parking areas, bushes, trees, grills, picnic tables, garbage cans, etc. Move outdoor items if needed to mow properly. You will be charged if maintenance has to come do the trim work at your unit. You must do both (mow and trim). DO NOT BLOW GRASS INTO THE STREETS. Save yourself the fees and cut and trim your lawn!

Messages From CCHA

Outdoor Water Use: Tenants are not permitted to use water outdoors under any circumstances. Hoses, pools, and water toys are all strictly prohibited. After an initial warning, tenants will be assessed a tamper fee of \$25.00 for violating water usage restrictions.

Charcoal and Gas Grills:

Keep grills in clear, open areas whenever they are in use. Properly discard cold charcoal, and turn off gas at the cylinder each time. Grills are permitted in family areas only.

Garbage:

Dispose of all household garbage every week. Garbage placed outside in the summer months attracts insects and is a health hazard.

CCHA strives to maintain decent, safe, and sanitary conditions for all tenants. Please do your part by getting rid of garbage weekly.

Outside Furniture/Items:

Only furniture designated for outdoor use is permitted outside your dwelling unit. Tenants are NOT permitted to have fire pits, wading pools or swimming pools (any size), swing sets, gym sets and trampolines. These items must be removed from CCHA property immediately.

Parks: Use the sidewalks provided and stay out of yards and porches of other residents unless invited. Dispose of trash properly when outside. CCHA has in the past received reports of people walking through the yards and littering on their way to and from the parks.
